

Liberty Christian Academy Scholarship

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Who qualifies for a Liberty Christian Academy scholarship?

The LCA scholarships are awarded to students who have a cumulative unweighted high school GPA of 2.75+, or a 900+ SAT, or a 19+ ACT and MUST graduate from LCA. The scholarship is based on the number of years a student attends LCA. The student MUST be in good standing with LCA. The student must have attended LCA for at least one year (see year* amounts listed below for which years count). They cannot attend any other college after graduating from LCA before becoming a student at Liberty University.

2. What is the dollar amount of the LCA scholarship?

The award is for tuition (after PELL, SEOG, and/or VTAG have been applied), and it is based on the number of years the student attended High School at LCA:

- 1 year * 25% coverage of tuition after PELL, FSEOG, VTAG have been applied
- 2 year ** 50% coverage of tuition after PELL, FSEOG, VTAG have been applied
- 3 year *** 75% coverage of tuition after PELL, FSEOG, VTAG have been applied
- 4 year **** 100% coverage of tuition after PELL, FSEOG, VTAG have been applied

*Only 12th grade high school counts

** Only 11-12 grades high school count

*** Only 10-12 grades high school count

**** Only 9-12 grades high school count

3. Does the FASA and VTAG (Virginia Tuition Assistance Grant) have to be applied for?

EVERY student is required to apply for FAFSA and VTAG. If the student does not apply for either one of the above, and the student would qualify for either one, the student will be responsible to pay the amount the student would have been qualified for. (i.e.: student has 100% tuition scholarship, student qualifies for VTAG, but student failed to fill out the form by the advised date, the student will be responsible for paying the VTAG amount (ex: 1500.00) per semester that the student would have received had he/se applied for VTAG by the deadline.)

4. Can the LCA scholarship be combined with any other scholarships?

The LCA scholarship CANNOT be combined with any other scholarships.

5. Does the Confirmation Deposit of \$250 have to be paid?

The Confirmation Deposit of \$250.00 is a required payment toward the student's account at the beginning of the enrollment process.

Refund Policy:

Your \$250 confirmation deposit will be applied as a credit toward your Liberty University account for your first semester of attendance.

A confirmation deposit may be refunded only if the request is in writing and received by April 1 for Fall applicants and December 1 for Spring applicants. You should contact our admissions office at admissions@liberty.edu or write to Liberty University at 1971 University Blvd. Lynchburg, VA 24502. The deposit is non-transferable and non-refundable after the above deadlines but may be deferred for up to one academic year should the student decide to attend in a subsequent semester. However, if a student updates their application to any other semester the student will no longer be eligible for a refund.

6. What are the academic requirements to be awarded the LCA scholarship?

The student MUST maintain a GPA of 2.75 OR have a 19 on their ACT composite scores OR have at least a 900 on the SAT Math and Verbal combined (excludes the SAT Writing score). A student MUST meet at least one of these three requirements in order to receive the LCA scholarship they are eligible for.

7. Can I use the LCA scholarship and be a part time student at Liberty?

The student MUST be a full time residential student (12 credit hours or more). The scholarship does not cover audit classes, intensives or, summer classes, unless a scholarship appeal is submitted to the Financial Aid Office.

8. How long does the LCA scholarship last?

The LCA scholarship will be allowed for 8 consecutive semesters of enrollment, up to 128 hours. If a student breaks their enrollment, they will lose the scholarship. If a student is placed on disciplinary probation or is suspended, completes a withdrawal, or is dismissed for any reason, the scholarship is subject to be reduced or removed.

9. Are there any restrictions?

The scholarship is designed for a 128 credit hours and no more than the minimum hours required in the undergraduate program if those hours 128. The scholarship is also ONLY for Undergraduate programs. It will not cover audits or intensives. The scholarship can be used ONLY in the fall and spring semesters; no summer semesters will be covered unless appeal is granted.

Internships may be covered if the student enrolls in the internship during the fall and spring semesters (however, the student has to pay ahead of time for the internship and will be later reimbursed). The scholarship MAY NOT be used to cover any fees (i.e.: technology fees, activity fees, transportation fees, class fees, vehicle registration fees, parking tickets, book fees, meal plans, etc...)

THIS SCHOLARSHIP CAN ONLY BE USED FOR LIBERTY UNIVERSITY RESIDENT UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM ONLY.
