*The Continual Enrollment Fee is a non-refundable fee and is due on **February 15**. You can opt out of your child(ren)'s Continual Enrollment Fee by notifying the Office of Student Accounts by January 31, 2026.

This fee is due with the application for all students. The student application/enrollment fee is a **non-refundable** fee.

TUITION RATES may be paid in full or on a semester basis (twice per year).

-A non-refundable deposit of 25% of total tuition cost is required upon signing the enrollment contract for new students and is due by March 31 for continually enrolled students for the upcoming school year.

-All families are required to establish a FACTS account. LCA does accept international payments through Flywire.

-There is a yearly non-refundable FACTS participation fee. The fee is \$25 for paid in full and semester payment plans.

FAMILY TUITION DISCOUNT PLAN is only available to families with three or more children enrolled in grades K-12 at LCA.

1. Eldest and second child pay full tuition.
2. Third child pays 70 percent of full tuition.
3. Fourth and successive children pay 50 percent of full tuition.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PROGRAM FEES AND LAB FEES are paid for each international student and are included in the tuition rate. This fee pays for the personal iPad rental fee for students in grades 8-12, for use of classroom iPads for grades K-7, field trip fees for grades K-5, graduation costs for Kindergarten, all textbook rentals (hardcopy, e-book, or downloadable), admission to all regular season home athletic events, the Attraction Value and Dining Guide, and a yearbook for students in grades K-12. Also included is the insurance premium (including sports riders and school physical exam fee), English as a Second Language courses, and other support services. This is a non-refundable fee. For senior students taking "Dual Enrollment" classes, the "Dual Enrollment" textbooks are not included in this cost. This fee includes use of our library online research database, wireless access, tech support, etc.

AP CLASSES (includes AP Test) \$100 per class

FIELD TRIPS for 6th – 12th grades are paid separately from tuition.

TARDY FEES are assessed for students who are late. A student who is tardy 5 times will receive a charge of \$15. A student who is tardy 10 times will receive a charge of \$30. A student who is tardy 15 times will receive a charge of \$45 and so on. These fees will be added to FACTS.

TRANSPORTATION FEES may be added to your FACTS account. Pick up and drop off points are centrally located. Please call the school for information regarding the points nearest your location.

Fees are based on Zone 1 (0-10 miles), Zone 2 (11+ miles), and number of students riding per family. There is a \$25 per trip fee for students not signed up for the bus who use the service.

LCA School Board policy stipulates that all accounts must be kept current, and no account may be in arrears by sixty (60) days or \$800. Violation of this policy may result in withdrawal until the account is made current.

Academic transcripts and final report cards will be held until an account is paid in full. Upon student withdrawal, the family will be financially responsible according to the LCA withdrawal policy.

Families who elect to send their children to LCA enter into a contractual agreement; therefore, they are obligated to pay full tuition for the school year as contracted. The continual enrollment fee, re-enrollment fee, application fee, student program fees, and lab fees are non-refundable.
