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- How do I schedule a meeting for my rising grade level student?**  
To schedule a meeting for your rising grade level student with their School Counselor, please click on their respective QR code and review the available slots. **Both students and parents are required to attend this meeting.** Virtual option available.

- When does the scheduling window close for families to make changes to course requests through RenWeb?**  
Families can make changes to course requests in RenWeb through Friday, February 20, 2026.
- How do we request a change after February 20 deadline?**  
To request a course change after the February 20 deadline, an email will need to be sent to [LCAHSGuidance@liberty.edu](mailto:LCAHSGuidance@liberty.edu) explaining the reason for the change.
- Where do I find course descriptions and qualifications?**  
All course information can be found in the Program of Studies on the Guidance webpage.
- How many electives do I need to list on my request form?**  
Grades 9-11 write in four elective choices. Seniors should add five elective choices.
- What are the differences between the Standard & Advanced diploma?**  
The advanced diploma requires: four years of English, math, science, social science, and three years of world language (or four years of two different world languages) along with the other seven required or elective classes. See four-year planning sheet for more details.



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- **How do I hear about important information from Guidance?**

The Guidance Office shares important upcoming dates and events that can provide your student with opportunities for scholarships and activities that can be added as part of a portfolio for future decisions through Bulldog Bark, Facebook, and RenWeb blasts.

- **When will student schedules be available?**

The scheduling process takes place during the summer and student schedules will be available at Meet and Greet in August.

- **How does my student submit CSER hours?**

Christian service hours will be submitted through the "[MobileServe" website](#). Please "[review the getting started](#)" document for instructions on how to set up a Mobile Serve account and the organization code for each high school grade level. **Class of 2030 code will not be available until June 2026 and will be emailed out in a RenWeb blast.**

- **How can my student prepare for the SAT or ACT?**
